


Research is a careful and detailed study into a specific problem, concern, or issue using the scientific method.

Medical Research Specific type of research to help identify causes of illnesses and develop better treatments.




International Governing Principles


Ask questions!

- Before, During and After the study
- Understand what the researchers are hoping to learn from the study
- Clarify what is expected of you and your child

You may stop participating at any point, even <u>after</u> you have begun the study



- Research = how we learn about illnesses and how best to treat them
- There are different types of research
 - Questionnaires/surveys
 - Blood/tissue samples
 - Drug/treatment testing
- You can ask questions about the research AT ANY TIME (before, during and after) you participate
- Make sure you understand what YOU will need to do during the research study
- If you decide not to participate in a study, you will still receive proper medical care from your doctors
- Talk to your children about the study THEIR opinion matters!
- You can STOP participating in the study ANY TIME!
