
Steps completed in Scotland : -


- Contact Endocrine team in Belfast & Western Trust to introduce ourselves
- Gather documentation from Fionn's nursery and medical professionals in Scotland to support the Educational Statement in Ireland to get the help for Fionn for him starting school.
- Contact the local school and have a meeting with the headteacher to discuss Fionn's care.
- Contact a local pharmacy in Omagh to discuss ordering in the medical supplies for Fionn (as well as my own!)



Steps completed in Ireland : -

- Contact Endocrine team in Belfast & Western Trust to advise that we were now based in Omagh and organise Initial consultations.
- Register with the local GP and ensure that transfer of medical supply documentation has been completed.
- Contact Nutricia Representative to rearrange Fionns medical supplies to be delivered in Ireland.
- Submit Educational Statement Application to the Education Authority
 - Local Doctor & Psychologist both came out to assess Fionn to make their reports for the Education Authority
 - Waiting 26 weeks for the final conclusion!!
- Reapply for Disability Living Allowance
- Reapply for Carers Allowance
- Register Fionn in local childcare and organise training for the staff for blood glucose monitoring and Gastrostomy feeds.
